One \$1000 scholarship awarded to 1 female graduating senior of WCHS

Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 3.0, and must be involved in extra-curricular activities (school-related or otherwise). Applicants must exhibit strong character traits and be civic-minded individuals, which would be representative of many of the traits that Major Larry J. Bauguess, Jr. (class of 1989) exhibited. (see traits below) We are looking specifically for a good balance between academics and extra-curriculars, resulting in a well-rounded, hard-working individual.

Funds will be distributed directly to the 2 or 4-year college of their enrollment in the student's name no later than August 1st 2011. If the student decides not to attend, funds will be refunded back. Winners will need to supply Bauguess Committee with proper funding address upon notification. Winners will be notified by May 4th. Winners will also be acknowledged at Senior Awards Banquet, with a photo and oversize display check - set for May 19th, 2011 at the Stone Family Center for Performing Arts.

Applicant Requirements:

• **Recommendation Letters:** Must be signed and sealed in an envelope and signed across the flap to ensure security. Both letters should be turned in with application.

- 1- By a member of the WCHS school faculty or coaching staff stating why the applicant is a good candidate of this scholarship. Cannot be a relative, but should have had direct contact with the applicant; either in class or on their team – not just in an advisory position.
- 2- By a member of the community stating why the applicant is a good candidate for this scholarship. This letter should not be from a staff member of a school or education system. May be a church leader, community/civic leader, sport instructor, scout leader, work supervisor, music teacher, etc....

• **Essay:** One essay, focusing on **one** of the core traits listed below. Essay should relate a specific experience or event when the applicant exhibited and relied on the trait chosen. Essay should be typed neatly and has no minimum length, but should not exceed 3 pages in a minimum type size of 11 pt.
